**Subject:** Parking

## Mr. Fournier and Chairperson Nazzaro,

I would like to follow up on parking as discussed from the April 1<sup>st</sup> meeting. I have spoken with Chief Cyr about on street parking. He met with Mr. Malasky to take a look at it. Mr. Malasky had concerns about parking on the street during the winter, which is totally understandable. I asked about the option of on street/overnight parking during the time of the year that the winter parking ban is not in effect. Chief Cyr said he would not have a problem with that and would support that if it is brought before the Highway Safety Committee. In addition to Central Street, South Street adjacent to the old fire station would be a good spot for 4-5 parking spots. That would certainly help out the business on that end of town.
