It's simple, the toilet is only meant to flush the three P'S – PEE, POOP AND PAPER. The label might say "FLUSHABLE" but disposable wipes and other products are clogging our sewer lines, damaging pumps and other equipment. Not only are these problems expensive to fix, they can also cause raw sewage overflow into homes, businesses and local waterways.

The following items should not go down the toilet they are made of materials that don't break down and can cause pipes to clog. DO NOT FLUSH!

- Disinfecting Wipes
- Baby Wipes and Diapers
- Paper Towel and rags
- Cotton Swabs
- Candy and other food wrappers
- Clothing labels
- Cleaning sponges
- Plastic items of any description
- Cigarette butts
- Sanitary products
- Dental floss
- Hair
- Kitty litter (especially clay kitty litter) will sooner or later clog your pipes, even the ones that claim to be " flushable"
- Prescription Drugs, over the counter meds and Household hazardous materials such as oil, pesticides, paint and solvents should never be flushed. All of these are highly toxic and will cause long-term damage to the environment.
