

BOAT REGISTRATIONS & RENEWALS

The Newmarket Town Clerk is a “Registered NH Boat Agent”

For your convenience, we are able to register or renew boats for any New Hampshire boat owner – not only Newmarket residents – here at Town Hall (agent fee of \$5.00 is added to each registration (RSA 72-A)).

PLEASE NOTE: By registering or renewing your Boat in Newmarket, **the Town of Newmarket is able to retain 100% of the “Boat Fee” portion of the registration, which would otherwise be paid to the State of New Hampshire** (RSA 72-A: 5). The remaining “Registration Fee” portion is remitted to the State of New Hampshire.

You may also choose to mail the renewal form to the State. All revenue will be retained by the State, and “... the fee shall be deposited in the navigation safety fund established under RSA 270-E: 6-a.” (RSA 72-A: 5).

Boat registrations expire annually on December 31st. The State of New Hampshire mails renewal registrations to owners in the late fall of each year.

RENEWING REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Previously issued registration or
- State of New Hampshire renewal notice/registration form

NEW REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

A Bill of Sale signed by both the buyer and the seller along with the following information:

- Model Year
- Make
- Fuel Type
- Horsepower
- Inboard/Outboard designation
- Single or Twin Engine
- Boat Length
- Boat Color
- Hull Identification number (1973 & newer must be 12 digits)
- Hull Material

ALSO if previously registered in New Hampshire you MUST provide the NH Bow Number or registration CANNOT be completed.
