Administrator Dixon stated that dispatcher Brian Dossett who was intending to resign in September resigned in July and was asking for pay for his comp time. He had accumulated between 80 and 90 hours of comp time, which was against the regulations. The Town has not paid for comp time in the past. He has filed a complaint with the Labor Board. The Town has the legal right to cap comp time. Mr. Dossett also stated that he had not been paid for holiday time. He left in July and was paid for the last holiday, which was Independence Day.

Administrator Dixon explained that Best Way's disposal contract expired in December. He asked the Council if they should consider Eric Weston from AWS. He also stated that he would continue to work with the Lamprey Co-op.

The Council discussed possibilities and suggested this issue go to the Solid Waste Committee and be sent back to the Council with their recommendations.
